**Letter to the claimants of ABLV BANK LUXEMBOURG SA (in judicial liquidation)**

Dear Madam, dear Sir,

On 1 March 2020, a list of statements of claims declared as eligible had been filed by the judicial liquidators with the registry of the District Court of Luxembourg where the declared creditors and those indicated in the balance sheet could inspect such list and raise objections.

In the context of the fight against Covid-19, the period for inspection and for filing objections had been extended to 24 August 2020.

In accordance with the judgement dated 2 July 2018, a list of statements of claim has recently been filed by the judicial liquidators with the District Court of Luxembourg.

As soon as the above-mentioned list is approved and signed by the bankruptcy judge, creditors whose claims are admitted shall be individually informed by simple letter sent by the liquidators. The judge has not yet indicated when the official list is meant to be released.

At the same time, the judicial liquidators will inform by registered letter the creditors – whose claims have been disputed or are subject of an objection by a third party which is admissible and considered not without merit -, about the reasons why the statement of claim has been disputed or objected.

In accordance with the decision of the District Court of Luxembourg dated 2 July 2019, these creditors must then proceed by way of summons within a period of 40 days from the mailing date of the registered letter to the post office.
